## The biggest...



- Kent, East Sussex, Essex, Medway, Southend Thurrock
- Aim is to drive economic growth across the South East
- One of 39 LEPs across the country established by Coalition
- Major priority is enabling new private sector jobs and homes
- Provides business lead in shaping Government investment in economic growth
- Housing delivery has been identified as a major priority

## South East Local Enterprise Partnership

## ...But also aims to be the most local

- "Overarching" strategic Board enables local decision-making according to local priorities
- "Federated areas" select SE LEP Board Members
- Kent & Medway Economic Partnership effectively a "mini-LEP"
  - Agrees local economic priorities
  - Prioritises projects and schemes
  - Brings together business and council leaders
- Kent & Medway Business Advisory Board (BAB)
  - Wider business forum from which KMEP members are drawn

- SE LEP Board last Friday
- Agreed LEP must always be best for business growth
- Strongly held views:
  - Break down into constituent parts (primarily based around county boundaries)
  - Retain the scale/current federal structure
- Alternatives to come forward to Government from Kent and Essex

## **Growth Deal**



#### **SE LEP Growth Deal with Government:**

- £480m
- Transport schemes, inc M20 J10A, Thanet Parkway, Tonbridge Town centre and £6m K&M "Growth Hub"

#### Down payment

£4b remains in Government's Local Growth Fund for competitive distribution

#### Flexibility within programme

Local management of capital programme according to local priorities

### • New freedoms/responsibilities

- Includes new responsibilities around skills, housing, transport
- Just the start...
  - Commitment from Government to devolution
  - Focus on jobs and housing
  - £12b national pot (with desire for more)



## **Building the Future: Our housing priorities**

- Deliver our Growth Deal!
- Bring together all parties (HCA, councils, developers, finance, utilities) involved to drive development forward
   Working together with local councils, the HCA and developers on large and priority sites, assembling evidence, identifying obstacles and finding solutions
- Encourage and support councils to bring forward their local plans

  Embarking on a series of meetings with planning authorities to support and review the local planning process, promoting development where it is wanted and protecting from unwanted development where it is not
- Review the performance of utility companies

  Gathering evidence of performance and taking action to ensure utility companies

  help not hinder local growth
- Promote best practice
   Supporting events and meetings to share best practice and information sharing to support all to the standard of the best (eg use of HRA debt cap, establishment of local development companies)
- Look across LEP boundaries
  Looking at the plans and proposals of neighbouring LEPs and their impact in preparing for accelerated growth.

- £180m won for the SE LEP area
- Structural Investment Funds =
  - European Social Fund
  - European Regional Development Fund
  - European Agriculture Fund for Rural Development
- To support business and skills across the SE LEP area

  - Through investment in fund, in projects, through brokerage

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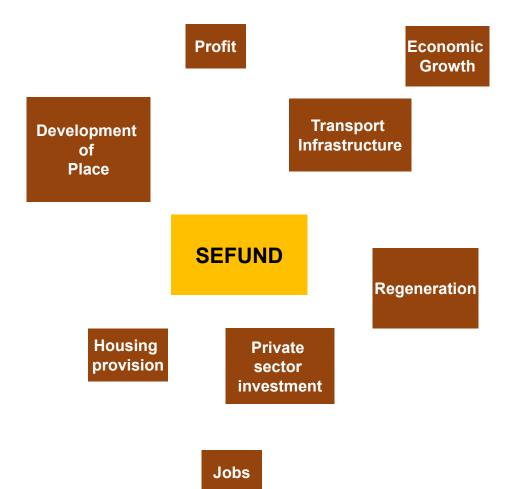

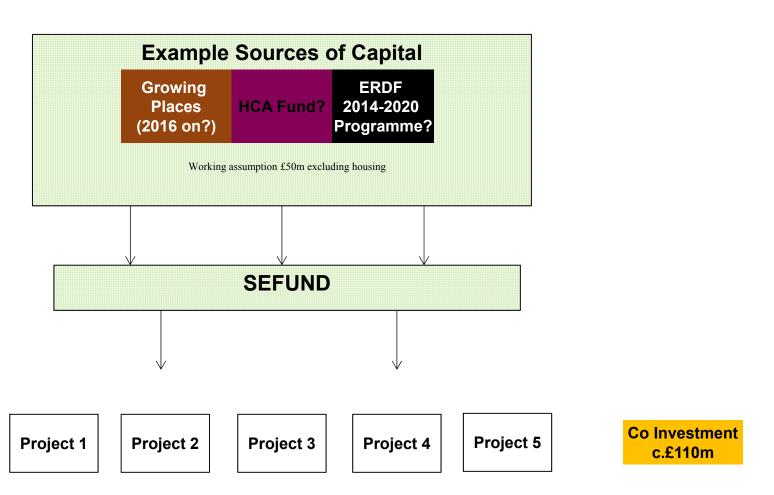

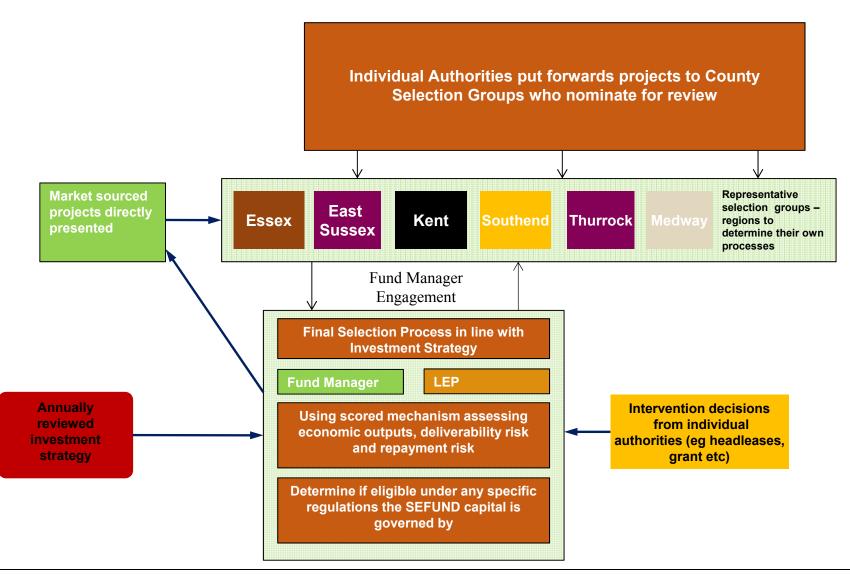


Flow of Funds



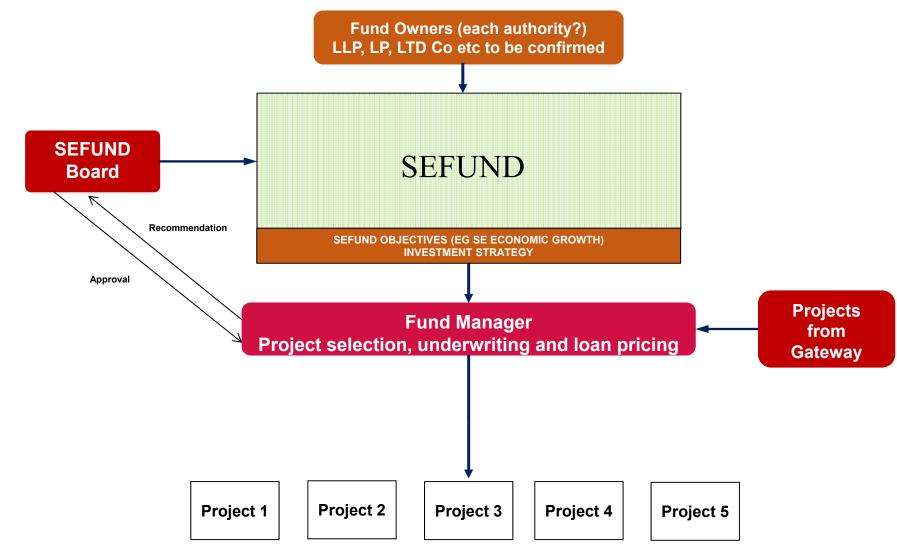
